SOME EXAMPLES OF TREATMENT

Depending on your pet's condition, we may use one or more of the following approaches

Weight loss if needed
Joint supplements
Joint support diets
Joint support injections
Anti-inflammatories
Physical therapies e.g. massage, physiotherapy
Environmental changes e.g. non slip mats
Patient support e.g. grip socks
Additional pain relief e.g. codeine
Adjunct therapies e.g. CBD oil
Advanced pain relief e.g joint injections
